

## Atlanta Property Group Employees Care for Stray Cats

Workers Seek To Find New Homes for Felines That Live Around Office Park

Employees of Atlanta Property Group, or APG, who have spent the past five years taking care of a colony of feral cats at Shadowood Office Park northwest of Atlanta, are working to find the felines new homes.

APG, founded by Jonathan Rodbell and Court Thomas, had managed the [three-building office complex](#) on Powers Ferry Road near Truist Park for several years, but the firm sold it last month to Woodside Capital Partners. APG team members vetted the cats, fed them, provided veterinary care and found homes for their kittens. They even gave them names including Lucy, Sally, Chuck and Radar.

"With local shelters overflowing, we wanted to do whatever we could to lessen their load by supporting the colony of cats we found on our campus," Sarah Stevens, an APG partner and senior property manager, said in an

email. "We hope to find our Shadowood cats the perfect homes with an abundance of the love and comfort these animals deserve."

APG said its employees are big cat and dog people. "Over 68% of the 54-person APG team have pets (80 dogs and cats in total), and 56% are rescue pets," APG spokesperson Aliya Seymour said in an email. "In this spirit, the team is donating \$2,500 to Atlanta-based LifeLine Animal Project — a nonprofit with a mission of ending the shelter euthanasia of healthy and treatable animals."
